### SITE offers you:

- Workspace in SITE Blackbox, a total of 3 weeks, either during period 1 or 2.
  Period 1: Week 33 36, August 15<sup>th</sup> September 11<sup>th</sup>.
  Period 2: Week 48 50, November 28<sup>th</sup> December 18<sup>th</sup>.
- Public activities planned according to the groups wishes, 2-3 events.
- Means of production of 150 000 SEK to dispose on artistic fees, travel costs, accommodation etc. according to the groups wishes.
- Technical support from SITE.
- Access to office spaces, meeting rooms and guidance from SITE during the residency period.

**Please note:** SITE Blackbox is 14 x 19 meters with 6 meters ceiling height. Full floor plan and specification can be found <u>here</u>.

**Selection** is done by SITE Artistic Advisory Group with a priority for artists who:

- Aims to develop contemporary circus as an art form.
- Works with disciplines which can be performed in SITE Blackbox.
